

YOUNG ACHIEVER AWARDS

Call for Nominations

The Auburn University College of Veterinary Medicine's Young Achiever Award is bestowed upon one or more members of the class that is celebrating its tenth anniversary. This year's honorees will come from the class of 2005, which will hold its 10-year alumni reunion during the college's Annual Conference in 2015. Honorees are known for their accomplishments in veterinary medicine, their outstanding community service, and their advancement of animal health.

The awards committee of the Alumni Advisory Council reviews the nominations and selects the recipients, who will be honored during opening session of the Annual Conference. The deadline for nominating members of the class of 2005 is March 15, 2015.

Nominees

There are three areas of eligibility for nominees:

- 1) Academia
- 2) Private practice
- 3) Other, research, and public policy (including service in government, industry, and the military)

The candidate must be a D.V.M. graduate of Auburn's College of Veterinary Medicine. The nominee should be known for accomplishments in veterinary medicine and/or have made an outstanding contribution to his or her community and the advancement of animal and human health in the 10 years since graduation.
