

Imaging File Transmission Options

Options for sending radiographs, ultrasound, CT, or MRI files to Auburn University College of Veterinary Medicine are listed below:

When sending files to AUCVM on a referral patient, please ensure the animal name and/or client last name is included in all file name attachments and e-mails to help us with tracking patient information.

1. DICOM SEND transmissions (preferred method)

Link through your imaging software (see below):

On the viewing/storage server where the exam was performed or is stored permanently, configure a DICOM remote host destination station (either an internal or external location). You need the 4 pieces of information to add Auburn University College of Veterinary Medicine Teaching Hospitals Picture Archive (PACS):

AE TITLE: rad-offsite (note this is case sensitive)

IP ADDRESS: 131.204.152.86

PORT: 4006

ALIAS NAME: AUCVM PACS

This method is a secure, point to point connection from your server to ours and creates a "Click and Send" to us for future use.

IMPORTANT: Please ensure that files sent via DICOM are unencrypted. Please be advised that we do not have constant monitoring of this server for new transmissions. **Send an email to referral@vetmed.auburn.edu to alert us that you've shared files via DICOM send.**

2. EMAIL: referral@vetmed.auburn.edu

To send a link to your radiography (ex: Antech - DarkHorse). If you must send jpegs, please send them attached to an email that includes pertinent patient information to referral@vetmed.auburn.edu.

For Cuattro users, please ensure that when sending imaging links, they are not "view only." There is a way to send a link with the option to download the images and this is what we need. A call to Cuattro technical support may be necessary to set up your software to allow this. 3. Cloud-Sharing : www.dropbox.com

Create a free, user account if you don't already have one. Upload the files to be shared. (DICOM preferred) Share the file link/permissions with referral@vetmed.auburn.edu

4. Conventional film:

Please send the images with your client. We will digitize the images and give them back to your client at time of discharge or mail them back to you, if the client should choose to leave them.
