Put your veterinary skills to work protecting the nation's livestock and poultry. Here's your chance to join the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) team!

APHIS is looking for veterinarians and animal health technicians to serve in 13-month term positions in states throughout the country. In these positions, you'll be able to:

- participate in emergency response activities for highly pathogenic avian influenza
- conduct local field activities in the state where you are hired

These jobs involve tasks such as:

- inspecting and testing livestock/poultry to detect animal diseases and parasites
- inspecting premises to insure compliance with regulations
- investigating reports of and diagnosing communicable livestock/poultry diseases
- certifying the health of livestock/poultry, aquatic species and their byproducts to be exported to other countries
