**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Serve as a Veterinarian for the Navajo Nation Chinle Clinic and Veterinary Mobile Unit. Provide Disease Diagnosis & Prescribe treatment for disease & disorders of animals, both Large (40%) and Small (60%) animals. To treat patients referred from other Navajo Tribal Satellite Clinics; To supervise clinic staff, maintain patient accounts, provide accurate records keeping practices; Performing surgeries is essential; provide legal documentation for livestock management on and off the reservation; Responsible to the professional and will demand a certain amount of time to spend in contract with other health professionals (I.H.S., USDA, etc) and Federal Veterinarians to insure livestock and human safety from communicable diseases; Ability to educate pet owners on the importance of external parasite control for the prevention of diseases or any outbreak that may occur; Attends meetings and provides technical assistance and services; Conducts investigations on special situations and circumstances; Also assist in providing input on the budget development, revenues and expenditures; 5 year commitment minimum.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- A doctor of Veterinary Medicine Degree, and two (2) years of progressively responsible, relevant clinic and/or office practice/work experience.
