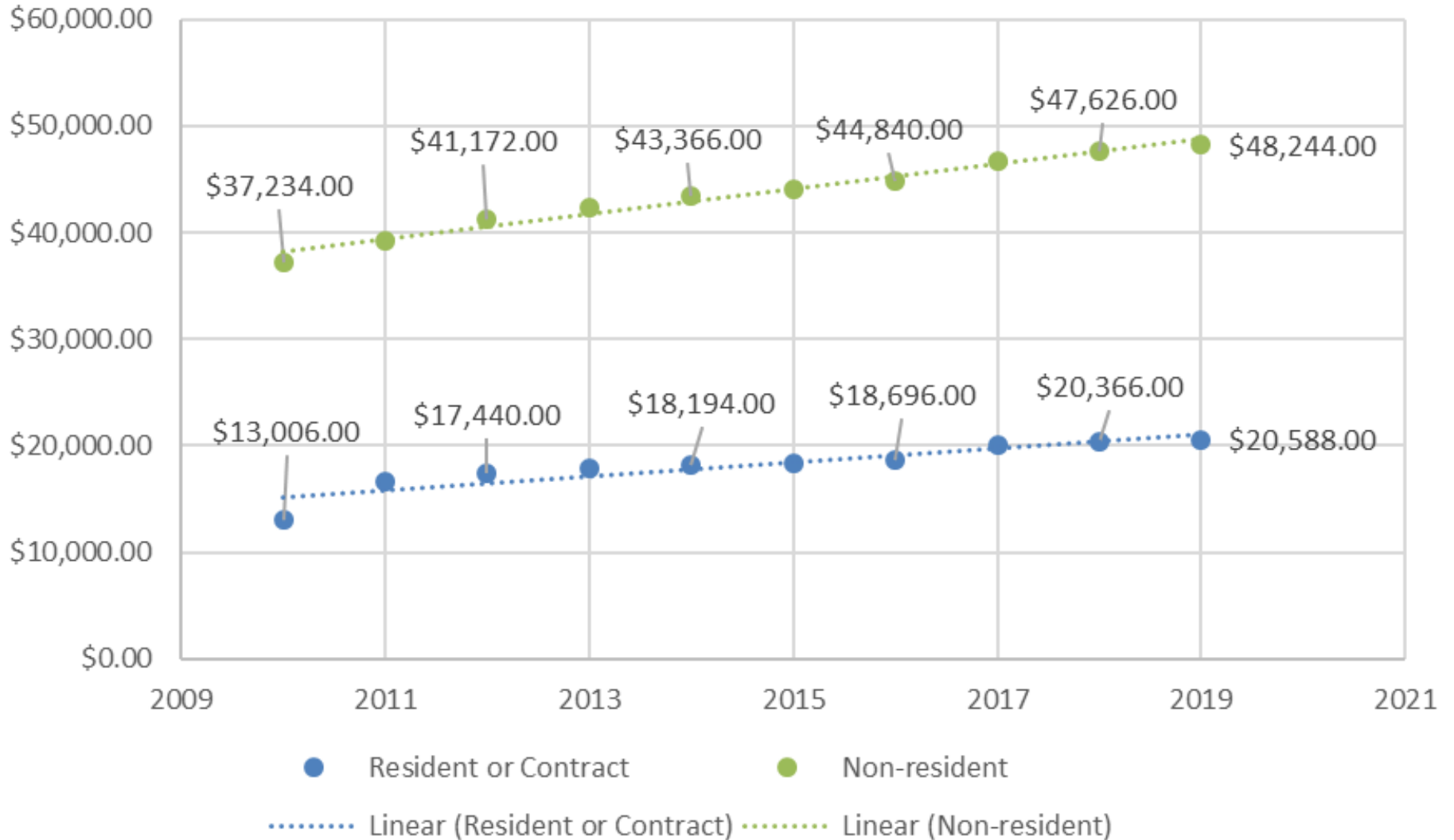

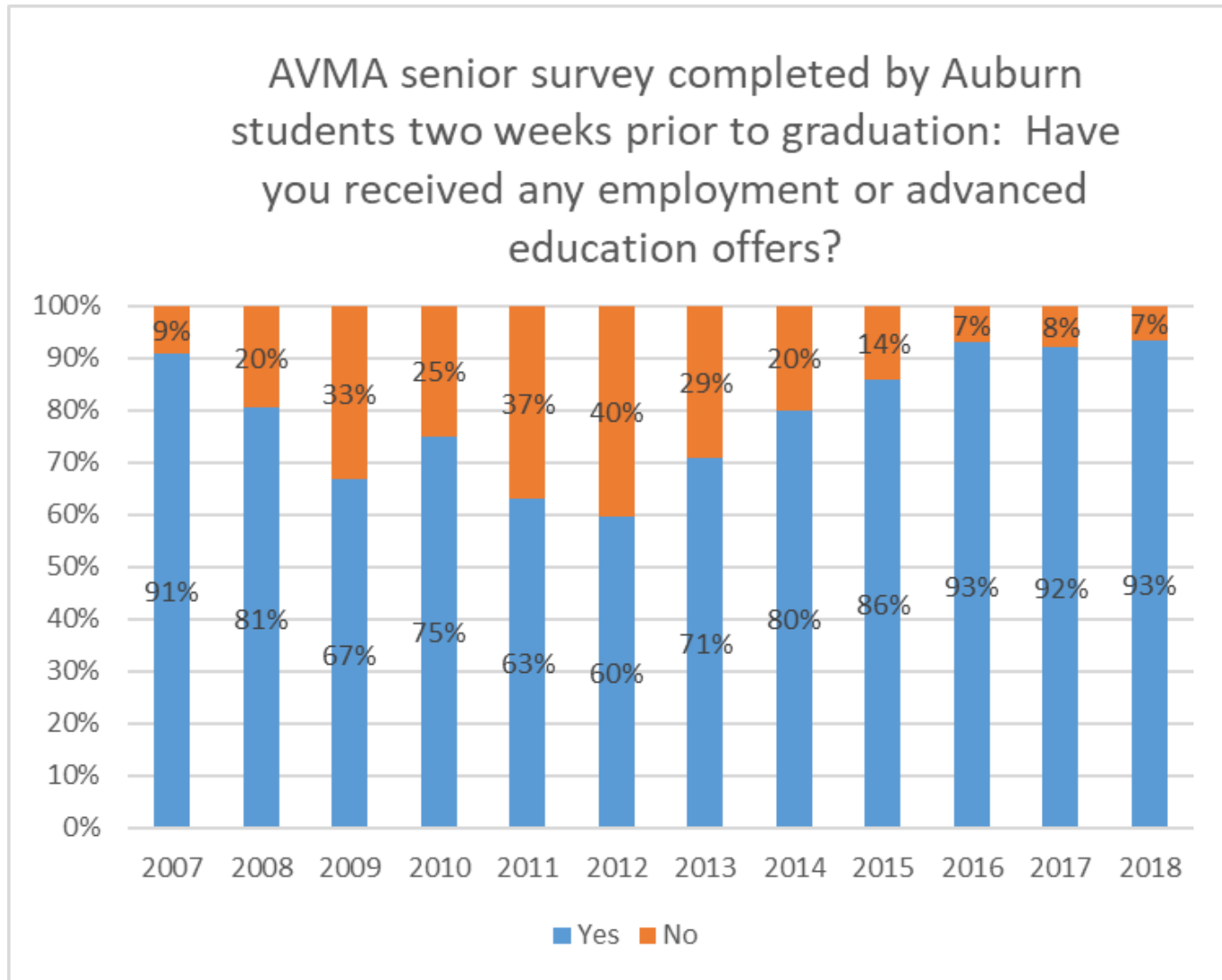

# AU CVM Two-Semester Tuition and Fees

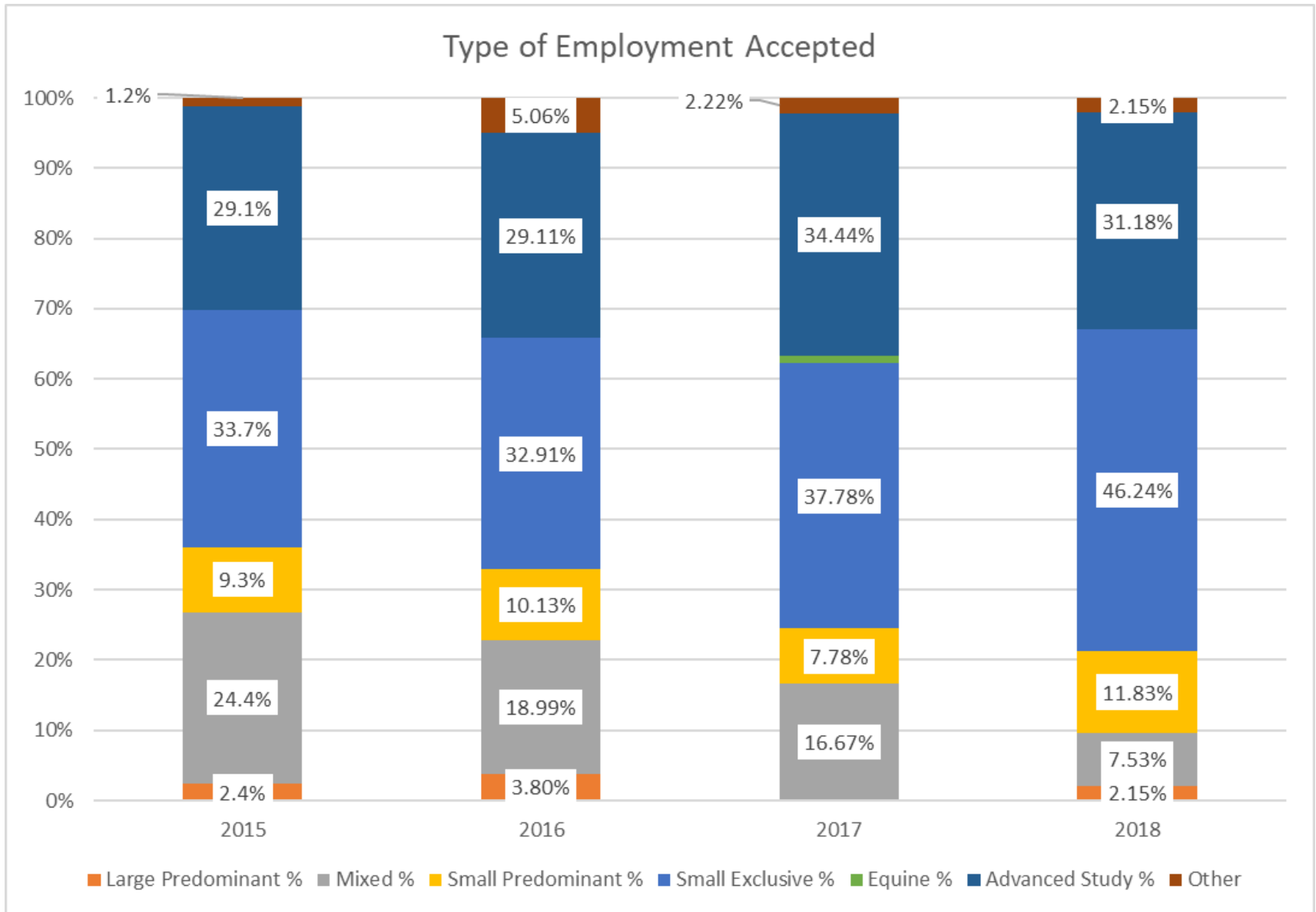


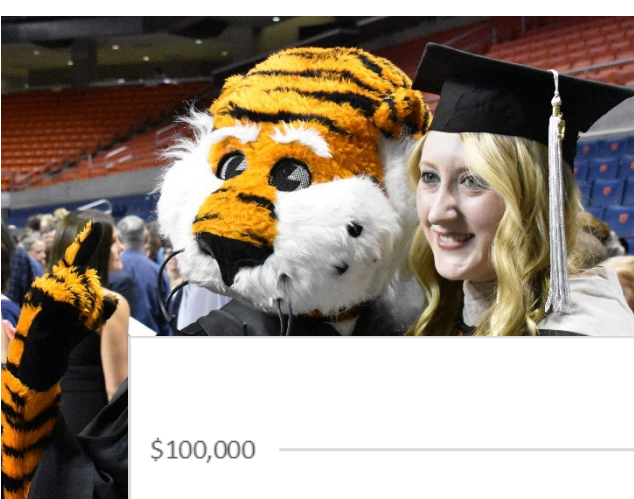

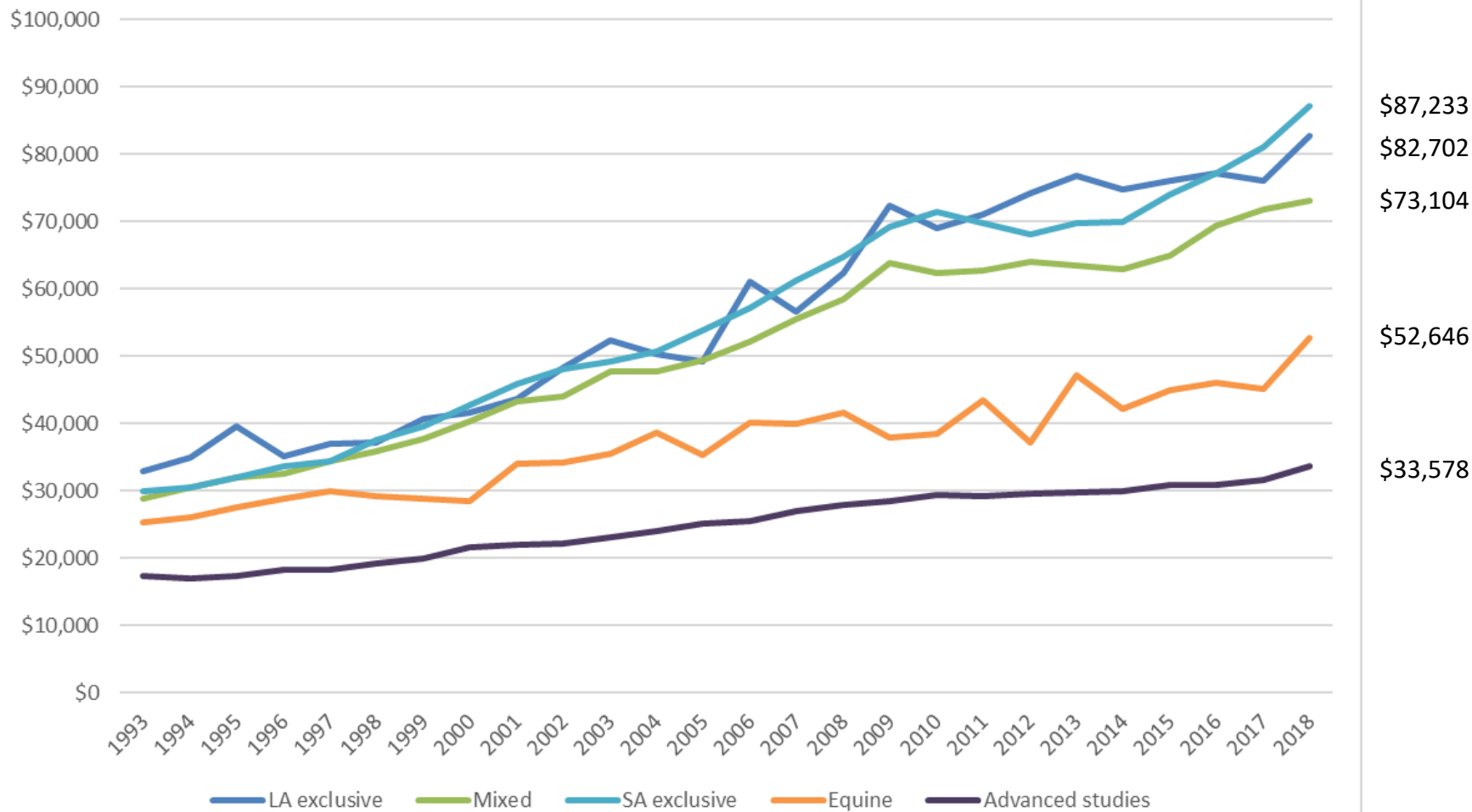
